ABOUT THIS WINERY

Château Gazin Rocquencourt is recognized as being one of the oldest wine estates in the commune of Léognan; its vineyard can be traced back to 1468. The house dates from 1660 and is still inhabited today. Historic property in Pessac-Léognan, it was noted in the guides Féret guide in 1874 for the quality of its wines and its terroir, situated on a superb gravelly hilltop in Léognan.

TASTING NOTES

There is a fine overall complexity and intensity, supported by an elegant tannin structure. This superb balance is accompanied by a long, flavourful finish.

PRODUCTION NOTES

Manuel harvest. Vinification in thermoregulated stainless steel vats. Ageing in traditional oak barrels, 40% new oak. Ageing for a period of 15 months.
